First aid skills (Inc. CPR, Drs ABC, using the defib) and responding in an emergency.

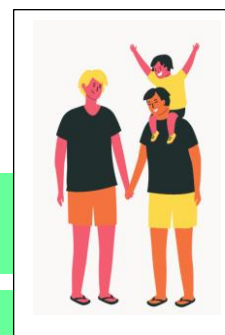
Lifestyle choices and impact on mental health and emotional wellbeing (Inc. sleep).

Self-efficacy, future opportunities, cultural capital, personal leadership, and readiness for work.



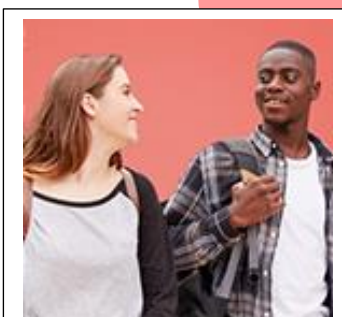
Financial decision making | financial products & services

Mental & physical health | Online relationships

Mental health and ill health, stigma, safeguarding health (Inc. during periods of transition and change).



Citizenship | Community cohesion & respect

Becoming a UK citizen, understanding human right laws and revoking citizenship in the UK. Migration, asylum and refugee status. Attitudes, legalities and developing factual opinions. British values & Equality Act 2010. Forming opinions about topical current affairs.
